WORKSHOPS

1st Woman and Law Workshop

A workshop was held on 22 August, 2013 with the attorneys who are on the Legal Affairs Committee to discuss the details of the seminars and training planned in the field of law.



1st NGO COMMUNICATION NETWORKING WORKSHOP

On Friday, 4 October 2013, a meeting was held, led by KADEM, with non-governmental organizations active in the field of working women in Istanbul; a common "NGO Communication Network" was established on how to increase the active participation of women in social, cultural, economic and political lives.



WORKSHOPS

WORKSHOP TO "CAMPAIGN AGAINST EARLY AND FORCED MARRIAGES"

A workshop was held on 23 January 2014 led by KADEM to promote the "Campaign Against Child Marriages." $\,$

Our workshop, "Campaign against Child Marriages", was held on 23 January 2014 with the participation and presentations of Aşkın Asan, Deputy Minister of the Family and Social Policies. Rıza Savaş, Dokuz Eylul University, Professor of Theology, contributed to the workshop by shedding light on the religious aspect of the topic.

At the workshop, attended by a number of non-governmental organizations, academics and workers at the Ministry of Family and Social Policies, a round table discussion was held regarding Early and Forced Marriages; the socio-cultural reasons for such marriages, the national and international agreements, the common role and status of these agreements in legislation were all discussed.



2nd NGO COMMUNICATION NETWORKING WORKSHOP

On 13 February 2014, the "2nd NGO Communication Networking Workshop" was hosted by KADEM, emphasizing the importance of solidarity in the movements and activities aimed at women. In the workshop, the present situation of existing women's NGOs was also discussed.



WORKSHOPS

21 February Workshop for Woman's Hostels .

On 21 February, 2014, a "Workshop for Woman's Hostels" was held by KADEM and attended by the General Directorate for the Status of Women of the Family and Social Policies Ministry, as well as a number of non governmental organizations active in the field of women's rights, executives from centers that prevent and monitor violence, supervisors of women's hostels, representatives of both the private sector and local governments.

KADEM, aware of the ever-increasing need for women's hostels in our country, discussed with experts the issues regarding the availability of hostels, the quality of the services provided and the proportion of requirements: solutions aimed at voicing these problems prior to the 2014 local elections were presented.



Workshop for the Role of Women NGOs in the Context of Democracy

In the workshop hosted by KADEM and attended by women NGOs in Istanbul, with the participation of Aysenur Islam, the Family and Social Policies Minister, discussions on topics including the status of women NGOs, the rates of performance in the social, economic and political lives of women, women and the media, women and art and women and family relations, as well as solutions to these issues, were presented.



TRAINING

Training in the Legal Rights of Women

In an attempt to highlight the issues facing women in the light of fundamental rights and freedom, KADEM organized "Training in the Legal Rights of Women" to inform women of the legal regulations that make women's lives easier.

As a pilot scheme, KADEM began to provide training and education in specific districts of Istanbul at certain intervals.

A total of **1,200** women obtained training in courses provided as part of the "Legal Rights of Women", organized in 9 districts of Istanbul.

It is intended that further training will be offered to **5,000** more women during 2014.

Training Women Candidates

On 22 February, 2014, KADEM organized "Training for Female Candidates in Local Administrations" aimed at providing training for almost 100 women council assembly candidates.

In addition to this training provided by KADEM, aimed at educating Female Candidate Members of the Council Assembly prior to the 2014 elections, emphasis was also placed on the importance of female candidates in local administration, and an awareness of how candidates can avoid the difficulties and obstacles they may face in becoming successful leaders was created.

In order to ensure that qualified and well-informed women candidates will participate in the local elections and take an active role on the local political stage, a joint project with the Istanbul Commerce University and Marmara City Council Union, KADEM presented the "Local Administration Certificate Program".

IF YOU ARE A MAN, OVERCOME YOUR ANGER!'

The International Day for the Prevention of Violence against Women Campaign

In an attempt to raise awareness of 25 November, "International Day for the Prevention of Violence against Women Campaign", KADEM headed the campaign with the slogan "If You're a Man, Overcome Your Anger!"

The public advertisement prepared by KADEM for the campaign was broadcast throughout the day on all national television channels. Posters and advertisements promoting the campaign were also exhibited on billboards in various districts of Istanbul, as well as in television programs and on Istanbul buses.

The slogan "If you're a man, overcome your anger!", broadcast in the social media, attracted vast attention, and the campaign, initiated to increase awareness and susceptibility to the issue, reached its target.

Campaign against Child and Forced Marriages

In addition to the workshop we organized in the Campaign against Child and Forced Marriages, in an attempt to raise awareness on the issue, our slogan also appeared in the social media.

This slogan, supported by all sectors of society, was highlighted in the social media.



I TOO HAVE A COMPLAINT!

A conference titled "Where do Women Stand in the February 28 Process", was held by KADEM, and presented by the lawyer, Fatma Benli on 8 February 2014.

With the slogan "I Too Have a Complaint!", symbolizing an awakening, this conference united the complainants of the February 28 process.

On 20 March 2014, KADEM participated and filed a complaint at the 13th Criminal Court in Ankara as part of the February 28 trial.

LECTURES




Lectures were given to explain all concepts related to women. Lectures delivered by experts in this field are given at certain intervals, and provide an analysis on a variety of subjects.
