

The WORLD Network aims to protect and implement women's rights, create social awareness, and prevent rights violations in participating countries




ACADEMIC STUDIES

KADEM contributes to the academic literature by producing scientific content with its own unique discourse in the field of women's studies.

The journal has been circulating since 2015 and covers various topics, including law, politics, economics, culture, art, anthropology, sociology, psychology, theology, religious sciences, and communication. Over the years, it has garnered a readership of more than 54,000 individuals.

KADEM Journal of Women's Studies, refereed and periodical, is published twice a year.

Colloquiums

KADEM offers scholarships to students pursuing undergraduate, graduate, and doctoral degrees. Our postgraduate students have the opportunity to participate in colloquiums, where they engage in high-level discussions with our **Academic Board** regarding these and pertinent topics in women's studies. We aim to significantly contribute to women's studies in the academic community through these colloquiums. We have successfully conducted four colloquia thus far and intend to perpetuate this practice in the future. We hope this will lead a enhanced engagement and further academic exploration.

SOCIAL **AWARENES** CAMPAIGNS

At **KADEM**, we organize social awareness campaigns on significant dates, including March 8th, **International Women's Day**, and November 25th, **the Day for the Elimination of Violence Against Women**. We believe these campaigns provide an opportunity for social transformation. To tackle the issue of violence from a unique perspective, we utilize digital media as a tool for dissemination. Furthermore, we support our public service announcements with field studies.

With the Declaration of Principles on Women's Rights, announced in 2021, we explained our mission regarding women's fundamental rights and freedoms and the right to privacy to the world in different languages. We have opened this declaration for signature at **imzamiatarim.com.**



PROJECTS

KADEM carries out activities and projects to strengthen the role of women in the world of business and economy, to increase opportunities, and to achieve equality of opportunity.



In the project, which began in 2016, prepares young girls under state protection for employment and life. This project aims to reintegrate young girls under state care into society by providing them with vocational training in various fields.



- 165 young girls were provided with educational opportunities.
- 118 of them successfully completed their training.
- 84 were placed in institutions, gaining employment rights.
- Girls who left their education were enrolled in distance education.





Nearly **3,000 women** have applied to the Women in Innovation project, which has been running for **eight terms**. Women who completed their education at the innovation camp and were deemed worthy of the award by referees' evaluation were supported in establishing their own companies. **250 women** received entrepreneurship training, resulting in the establishment of **14 new companies** by the graduates. In the upcoming term, the project will continue to grow as a guided initiative.





Believing that every woman deserves to live with dignity, KADEM established the Women Support Centre Project. The aim of this project is to empower women individually by helping them continue their education, participate in business, and enhance their physical and psychological well-being.

We have provided services to **7,000 women** at women's support centers, and **2,000 women** have received vocational training.

KADEM considers the social needs and regional conditions of women while carrying out projects.

In that sense, KADEM cares about the cleanliness of places of worship and responds to needs; it also supports rural women in turning their efforts into initiatives for their economic development. While doing all this, projects are developed to increase the institutional capacity of employees and representative offices.



Our platform, **KADEM Art**, deals with women, family, and societal issues through art.

We organize competitions for photography, short films, scripts, documentaries, stories, and art exhibitions.

CIVIL ACTIVISM & ADVOCACY

The Civil Activism programs of KADEM aim to prevent the violation of **the rights of women and girls** and eliminate any discrimination against them. Through a multifaceted approach that includes academic research, social campaigns, educational programs, youth activities, and projects, KADEM is committed to **promoting civil activism**.

KADEM seeks to engage with policymakers to influence policies related to women positively. In addition, **KADEM closely** monitors cases of violence, murder, insult, harassment, and stalking to prevent such acts and ensure that the perpetrators receive just punishment. KADEM is dedicated to addressing the grievances of the victims in these cases while ensuring that women, children, and families are protected from harm.

KADEM strives to be the voice of women worldwide through its campaigns and press releases. With the "International Civil Support for Palestinian Women" press conference and installation in NY Times Square, KADEM expressed its solidarity with Palestinian women and called on global support. Local and international activists addressed the press, and the installation prominently featured traditional Palestinian embroideries.
